

2018 Long Island Psychology Fair

Project Description Instructions

Directions: For each project, create a one-page Project Description in Times New Roman font and send it in a Word document.

- At the top of the page, center the first initial and last name of the principal investigator, an underscore and the project title; **this must also be the name of your file**; (e.g., aweseley_Are People Who Run Science Fairs Masochists?).
- In order to ensure an unbiased review, students must NOT put any additional identifying information (e.g., first full name or school name) on their Project Descriptions. Note: Reviewers are a mix of university professors, psychology teachers from out of state, clinicians, etc.)
- Divide the Project Description into the following four labeled sections: Background, Method, Results, Discussion
- Single space the text within each section and double space between sections
- Word limit = 400 words; make sure to provide a word count at the bottom of the page. Points will be deducted from project descriptions that are too long or that do not include a word count.

Project Descriptions (each in a SEPARATE Word document) must be attached to a single email and sent by school liaisons to LIPsychFair@aol.com by noon on Friday, October 13, 2017. These instructions also appear in the “How to Apply” section of the website (www.LongIslandPsychologyFair.com).

Failure to follow the above instructions may result in disqualification.
